Progress report since last Town Council meeting:	<p>The following report summarises activity for the period under review. I would like to take this opportunity to thank the CCTV team for their continued dedication and professionalism in keeping our town safe. Their work makes a real and tangible difference to the safety and wellbeing of Stratford-upon-Avon.</p> <p>Activity Summary</p> <p>During the reporting period, the CCTV team recorded a total of 1,992 incidents across the town centre, reflecting the breadth and volume of operational support provided. A breakdown of incident types is provided below, along with call activity and outcomes. The volume and variety of incidents managed underlines the value of CCTV to the town's safety infrastructure. The Town Council's continued support for this partnership is well-placed.
