<b>Access &amp; Diversion:</b> An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Maidenhead Road, St Gregorys Road, Welcombe Road, Warwick Road, Bridgeway, Bridgefoot, Bridge Street, Guild Street, Birmingham Road, Shakespeare Street, Mulberry Street, Great William Street and vice versa. Vehicular access & egress will be maintained where possible
