Reason for Order	To safely enable the repairs to a defective manhole frame and cover. Road Closed 0930-1530 hrs.
Order Effective from: 16 February 2026 for up to 18 months or until works are completed, whichever is sooner.

Access & Diversion: An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Glebe Road, Bishopton Lane, The Ridgeway, Alcester Road, Brookside Road, Drayton Avenue and vice versa. Vehicular access & egress will be maintained where possible.
